University of Novi Sad (<http://www.uns.ac.rs/>) is the second largest among six public universities in Serbia with 42 000 students and more than 4000 employees. The head of the local organizing committee is Prof. Veljko Malbaša, Department of Power, Electronics and Telecommunication, Faculty of Technical Sciences, University of Novi Sad, Serbia.

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Novi Sad, Serbia



Novi Sad, the capitol of the north Serbian province of Vojvodina, is located at north slopes of the mount Fruška Gora, at the left bank of the Danube river. Novi Sad is second largest city in Serbia with a population of over 300 000. Novi Sad area consists of three districts: the largest one is the city of Novi Sad, and Petrovaradin and Sremska Kamenica are small towns located on the opposite, right hand bank of the Danube River.

The oldest part of Novi Sad area is Petrovaradin, which is populated since 4500 BC. The most successful period of Petrovaradin was during the rule of Habsburg Queen Maria Theresa (1740-1780). She built strong fortress over the Danube River and made Petrovaradin a very important city for the defense of Habsburg Empire. It took 88 years to build the fortress and it was built by prisoners, soldiers and volunteers. The fortress is often called the Gibraltar at Danube, because it had never been taken over by any army. It was military garrison and prison by the end of the Word War II. The left bank of Danube was settled during the XV and XVI century, when the Eastern Orthodox Serbian population moved from Kosovo to Vojvodina.



Novi Sad is a cultural and political center of Vojvodina. It is the home of numerous festivals, cultural manifestations, fairs and concerts. Novi Sad is the home of Matica Srpska, the oldest Serbian national library and the first public and scientific library of Serbs, founded in 1826, and Serbian National Theater, the oldest Serbian professional theatre, founded in 1861.

Being a home to different religions and nationalities, Novi Sad has 6 orthodox churches, Jewish synagogue and a Catholic Church in very hart of the city.

Novi Sad has a moderate climate with four seasons. Autumn is longer than spring, with long sunny and warm periods. The average September temperature is about 21 °C. Novi Sad is in Central European time zone, the same time zone as Paris, Rome, Berlin, Vienna, Budapest, Bratislava, Brussels, and Zurich.

Transportation

Novi Sad is 75 km northwest from Belgrade, the capital of Serbia. You can reach Novi Sad by car from Budapest, Hungary, traveling south about 290 km via E-highway. Novi Sad is east 375 km from Zagreb, the capitol of Croatia, via E-70 (A3). If you travel from Vienna, the capitol of Austria, take E-75 highway (A6 and M5), to Budapest, and than continue south to Novi Sad and Belgrade.

Novi Sad uses Belgrade airport 'Nikola Tesla' (international code BEG), which is about 75 km away. One way ticket by taxi from/to airport is around 25€ per person.

There are train lines from Vienna and Budapest to Novi Sad (continuing to Belgrade). More information you can find at site of Serbian Railroad Company:

Public transportation

Public transportation in Novi Sad covers the whole city area. Ticket price is 40 dinars (0.40 €) and it is valid for one drive. You can buy a ticket from the bus driver at the front entrance of bus.

Taxi transportation

There are several taxi organizations (Novus, Lav, Naš) and the average price for taxi within the city limits is between 150 and 300 dinars (1.5 to 3 €). If you ask, the taxi driver will write you a receipt for the ride. Currency

The official currency in Serbia is 'dinar' (RSD) and it is used in all shops, restaurants and in public transportation. You can exchange your currency in the currency exchange offices (in Serbian: 'Menjacnica'). The official exchange rates are clearly displayed on the windows. The current exchange rate for EURO is:



1 EURO = around 103 DINARS

Shopping

For shopping in the downtown you will have to use RSD (or shortly Dinar). The Euro is not accepted in supermarkets, shops and bars in Serbia. You will find at least ten exchange office in downtown with displayed exchange rate. In downtown you will be able to find bank offices and ATMs (Erste Bank, Intesa Bank, Raifeisen, Eurobank EFG,...). Most of the shops, supermarkets and restaurants accept credit or debit cards (Visa, Visa Electron, Master, Maestro, Diners). Please check before making purchase.

Working hours of most of the shops in Novi Sad on working days are 9 am to 8 pm and 10 am to 2 pm on Saturdays. Most of restaurants and bars in Novi Sad are open from 10 am until 2 am.

MOBILE PHONE

Three mobile phone companies operate in Serbia: TELENOR (www.telenor.rs), MTS (www.mts.telekom.rs) and VIP (www.vipmobile.rs).

INTERNET

We will provide wireless Internet access points in the meeting rooms at the University of Novi Sad. There are several internet cafes in downtown.

Electricity

Power network in Novi Sad operates at 230V and 50Hz with standard 2-pin outlets.

Visa and Travel Insurance

All travelers to Serbia must have valid passports. Citizens of European Union and other European countries don't need visa to enter Serbia. Please contact your travel agency for the information on medical and travel insurance.

Accommodation

We made reservations for the participants in the hotels listed below. Please select a hotel in which you prefer to stay and confirm your reservation before the suggested date. When contacting the hotel please state that your reservation is for the COST IC0806 conference, and if there is any problem please mention the name of the local organizer (Prof. Veljko Malbasa). We suggest that you confirm reservation on time, because the hotels set aside a limited number of rooms which will be offered on a first come first served basis.

Hotel Park (<http://www.hotelparkns.com/>) is a 5* hotel, with 225 rooms providing air-conditioning, TV, Internet access and direct phone lines. Price for a single room with breakfast is around 80€ and for double room around 90€.



Hotel Voyager (<http://www.voyagerns.co.rs/>) is a 4* hotel is located next to the University, with 2 minute walk to our meeting rooms and 10 minute walk to the center of the city. The hotel has 20 single/double apartments. Most rooms have Internet access, air conditioner, cable TV and mini bar. Price for a single room with breakfast is 58€, and for a double room around 60€. The hotel set aside 10 rooms, but you will have to make your reservation by August 1, 2010, at the latest.

Hotel Aleksandar (<http://www.hotelaleksandar.rs/>) is a 4* hotel located about 15 minute walk from University and 20 minute walk from downtown. It has 20 rooms and 7 apartments. All rooms are with air-conditioners, cable TV, internet connection, direct phone line, mini bar. Price for single bed room or two bed room with breakfast is around 70€.



Hotel Vojvodina (<http://www.hotelvojvodina.co.rs/>) is a 3* hotel located at main square in Novi Sad city center. It is one of the oldest hotels in Novi Sad, it has over 150 years of tradition. Hotel Vojvodina has 61 rooms with direct phone lines and own bathrooms. The price for night with breakfast is around 35€ for single and around 50€ for double room. The hotel will hold 15 rooms for the participants until August 1, 2010.

Hotel Putnik (<http://hotelputnik.rs/index.html>) is a recently renovated, 3* hotel located in the very center of the city, with 6 apartments, 29 single and 48 double rooms. All rooms have direct phone line, mini bar, and cable TV. By the end of summer it will be promoted to a 4* hotel. The price in a single room with breakfast is around 45€ and in double room around 60€. The hotel will hold 15 rooms for the participants until August 1, 2010.



Hotel Centar (<http://www.hotel-centar.rs/>), is a 3* hotel built in 2010. It is 2 minute walk from pedestrian area of town and offers 49 rooms and 2 apartments. All rooms have direct phone line, cable and wireless internet, cable TV. Single room with breakfast is around 60€ and double room around 80€. The hotel will keep 15 rooms for the participants until August 1, 2010.

Hotel Zenit (<http://hotelzenit.rs/>) is a 2* hotel, located in downtown of Novi Sad, next to the pedestrian area, offers rooms with internet access and TV. The price for a single room with breakfast is around 50€ and for a double around 60€. We have reserved 18 rooms and the participant has to confirm reservation before September 1th.

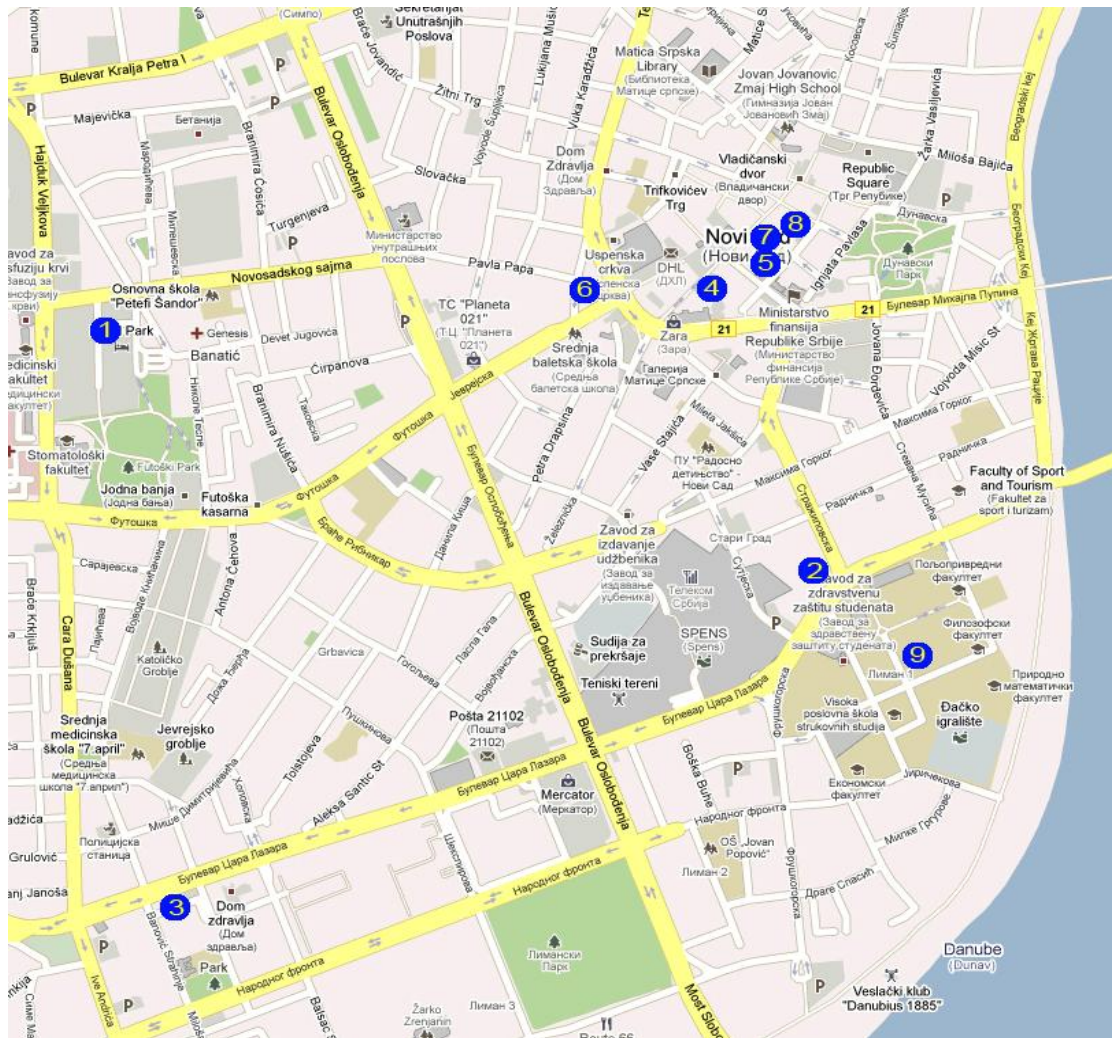
Hotel Mediteraneo (<http://www.hotelm Mediteraneo.rs/index2.htm>), 2*, is located next to hotel Zenit, few minute walk from pedestrian area of Novi Sad. It was built in 2005 and has 11 single bedrooms and 3 double bedrooms. All rooms have internet access, cable TV and air-condition. Single room with breakfast is around 46€ and double room is 62€. We have reserved 10 rooms and the participant has to confirm reservation before September 1th.



Transfer from/to airport

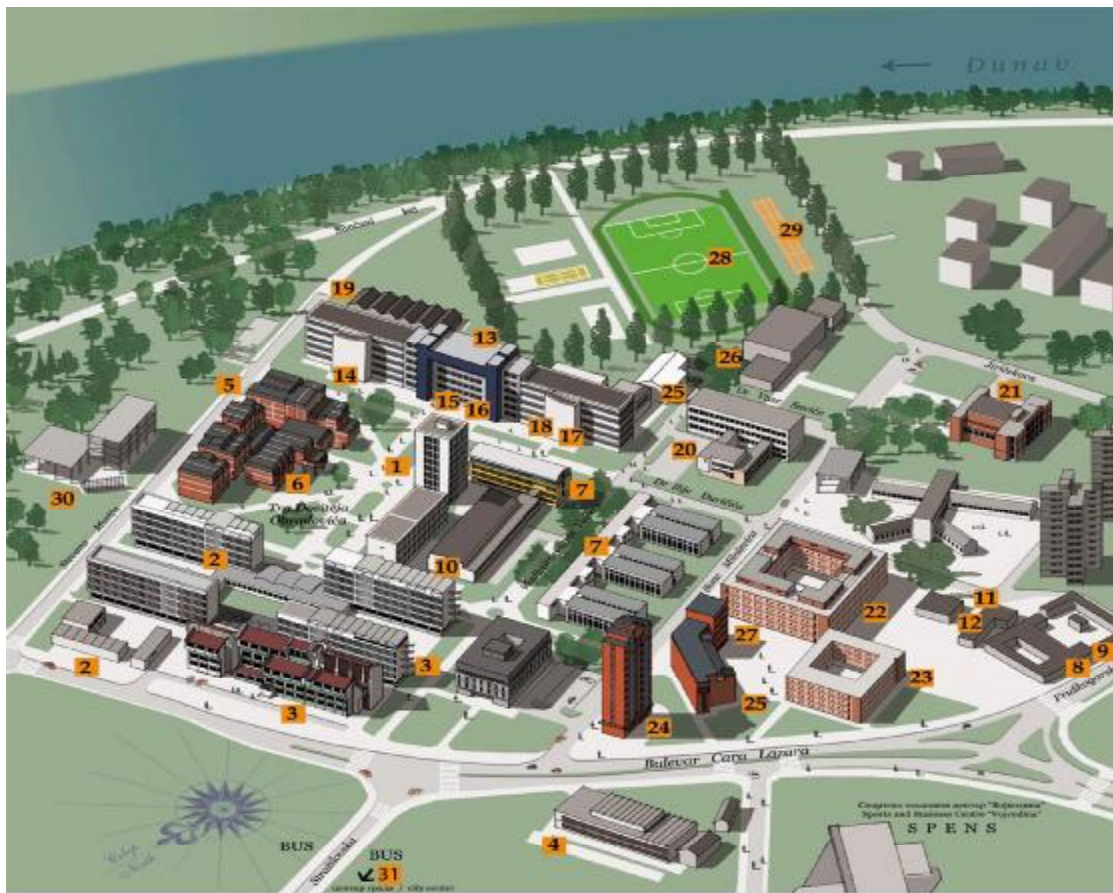
